Course preparation	Prior to the course it would be beneficial if the students were taught the 5 basic boating knots including. Clove hitch, round turn and 2 half hitches, figure of 8, bowline and reef knot.			
Session	Chevington Champ			
1	Preparation of boat and crew.			
Understands	Including, boat bag, boat hook, keys. Understands the contents of the bag and their uses. Fuel safety, Personal safety including clothing and the correct fitment of a buoyancy aid.			
Understands	Boat checks from stern to bow including, fuel, bilges, gears, coolant, oil, visual checks, isolator key.			
Can perform	Can start and stop the engine including checking water circulation, Fasten to a cleat OXXO and stow the anchor.			
Joyride	Joyride: explain area of operation. Loading and balancing the boat. Local bylaws including speed limits. Crew numbers Awareness of other water users including effect of wash. Students to have a go on the helm.			

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Session 2 can	Prepare the boat ready for leaving the pontoon including the terms, on the slip, ready, and secure.			
Understands	Rules of the road including safe speed, keeping a lookout, starboard side of the river. Commercial users in confined waters.			
Can name	Parts of a boat including port, starboard, bow, stern, tiller			
Practical session	Controlling the boat. Turning to port, starboard. Slowing down, carrying way. Effects of wind and tide.			
3	Revise session 1 and 2			
	Picking up and securing to a mooring buoy and coming alongside.			
Knowledge of.	Mooring buoy. Preparation of mooring warps. Use of boat hook. Method of approach. Crew communication. Making fast.			
Knowledge of.	Leaving and coming alongside including wind effect and tide. Use of crew. Preparation and communication.			
Understands	Leaving ahead or astern			
4	Revive previous sessions			
Can	Can Demonstrate the use of painter, lines and fenders, attachment to the boat and stowage while underway. Control speed and angle of approach. Make fast alongside.			
	Man overboard			
Understands	How to stop the boat. Raise the alarm. Prevention
